Classroom Rules/Procedures

Advisory & Instrumental Music Classes

- Students must abide by the MMS & LAUSD Codes of Conduct.
- Students must adhere to the MMS & LAUSD Dress Codes.

Before Entering

- Use the restroom before class starts – no restroom passes during class.
 - Wash hands before class.
- Students will enter & exit classroom in an orderly manner – walking, not running.
- All students should have proper materials before entering class, including agenda books, lined paper, 3-ring binder, and pencil with eraser (no pens used in class).

Inside the Classroom

- No food, drinks, gum, or candy allowed in the classroom at any time.
- All trash is to be put in the trash cans, not left on floor, on the chairs, or on the music stands.
 - No profanity will be used in the classroom at any time.
 - No throwing any items in the classroom.
- No toys, trading cards, electronics, skateboards, etc. in the classroom.
- Students will not touch anyone else's instrument or personal property.
- Students will use all equipment & materials in an appropriate manner, as instructed by the teacher. No vandalizing, defacing, destroying, or taking of school, teacher, or another student's property.
 - Students will treat each other & the teacher with respect.

- One person talking at a time – raise hand silently & wait to be called on - do not shout out in the classroom.
- If teacher blows whistle, stop what you are doing immediately & await further instructions/announcements.
- Instruments are to be cleaned carefully before putting them away, and all materials stored properly at the end of each period.
- Teacher’s desk/supplies, computer, & workroom are “off limits” without special permission.
