Students should use the music Students' Responsibilities list, a. k. a. Music Students' Criteria Chart, as a guide for what to strive for on each assignment and test.

Playing Tests (refer to specific rubrics charts for various instruments):

Some are only pass/fail: 5 points or 0 points

Some use 5 point grading scale:

5 points - Done excellently.

4 points - Just a couple of minor problems.

3 points - Basic concept, but still several problems.

2 points - Many problems with performance.

1 points and below - No basic understanding of the piece tested.

Adding + .5 points means closer to the next grade up.

Written Assignments: Differing in total point values, per assignment.

90% and Up is an A

80% to 89% is a B

70% to 79% is a C

60% to 69% is a D

59% and below is a Fail

Group Performances:

50 points Grading scale:

Pass or fail only if the student participates or not.

Categories for Grading:

Attitude - Positive attitude about the performance.

Attendance - In attendance for the performance.

Appearance - Dressed appropriately for the performance.

Audience - Was a good audience member while not performing.

Behavior Problems & also Missing Materials (mouthpieces, etc.):

Special grade, deduction of 1 point per assignment.
